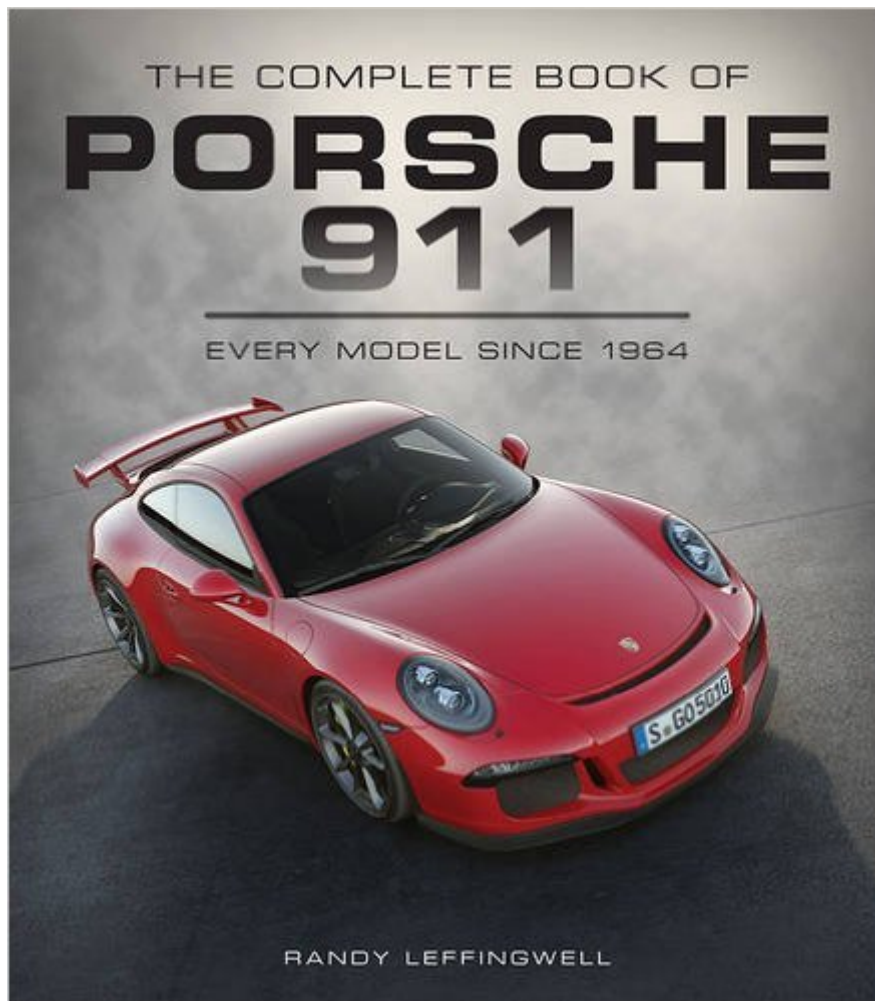

This is a very nice book with a lot of beautiful pictures of the 911, from the beginning to 997.

However I am somewhat disappointed that there is very little technical detail, beyond the customary "horse power, 0-60, top speed" stuff. The pictures are all of the exteriors, interiors and just a few engines from the open engine bays, and nothing at all for suspensions, chassis, all-wheel drive system, cutaways and etc., that show how they have "conquered the laws of physics".If you want to

enjoy the showroom views of the 911 over the years this is a great book, but if you are interested in the details of its mechanical evolution, this is not it.

I was looking for an index style book on porsches. Something that would chronologically list each and every 911 ever made with a little paragraph and mechanical and statistical data. What I got was a very well written book and informative boook on the history of the 911 and the various models. But it's a book better read from cover to cover and not a reference guide where you can easily look up a model and year and read about that specific car. It's still a great book though and well worth the price tag.

I bought a Porsche 911 which I justified by saying bucket list. Then, of course, I had to buy accessories. Stuff like a Porsche hat, car cover, cleaning supplies, and books. I ordered a few of the 911 books and kept this and 997 book which is specific to my car. I thought this was the best of the 911 books because it is not huge and heavy and covers all the models including the pre 911 models. Another book I like is "The Gold Plated Porsche" which is available on kindle.

I spend every week, unwillingly watching Top Gear with my husband who spends the entire hour gushing over the Porsches. With that said, I knew a coffee table book of this kind would be the perfect gift. Shockingly, I couldn't find anything remotely close to this nice at the big box stores. I am so grateful I found this book for my husband, who is very difficult to shop for, because he never asks for anything. He loves the book so much that he actually leaves it out as if it were a piece of art!
